Space and manoeuvrability

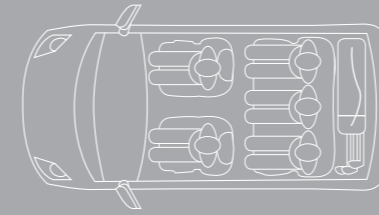
The compact Sirion defies conventional wisdom about compact cars to give you the kind of roominess that you need to truly relax. Sliding behind the steering wheel, you'll notice the generous amount of space between your seat and the front passenger seat beside you. When we designed the Sirion we made sure that both driver and passenger would enjoy the room and comfort of a larger car.

Rear passengers will enjoy the ride too, thanks to the generous leg room between the front and rear seats. Don't take our word for it, check it out for yourself and be prepared to be surprised.

The luggage space will also come as a big surprise, as it will take a couple of golf club bags equipped with clubs without the need to fold down the rear seats. Incidentally, the 60:40 split folding rear seat gives maximum versatility for passenger and luggage loads, turning the Sirion into a real load lugger whenever you need it.

Thanks to its compact body and electric power steering the Sirion corners and parks with consummate ease. And at just 9.4 metres its turning circle is the smallest in its class.

Comfort and equipment

We've already seen that the Sirion has comfortable space in abundance. And just to make sure you are really comfortable all Sirions come with a height adjustable steering column and, with the exception of the 1.0 S, they all have driver's seat height adjustment.

The Sirion is full of equipment that has been sensibly designed. Take the radio/CD player for instance. No more groping for tiny buttons to change channels. No more looking for the volume control. The integrated radio/CD player has large, easy to see and easy to use controls. The speedometer is mounted on the height adjustable

steering column. This means that when you adjust the steering column for height you never obscure the speedometer.

And every Sirion also has air conditioning, electric power steering, electric windows front and rear, driver, passenger and side airbags, and ABS with EBD – the list goes on...

And this isn't the top of the range model we are talking about. All of this equipment and more comes as standard on all Sirions.

Advanced technology

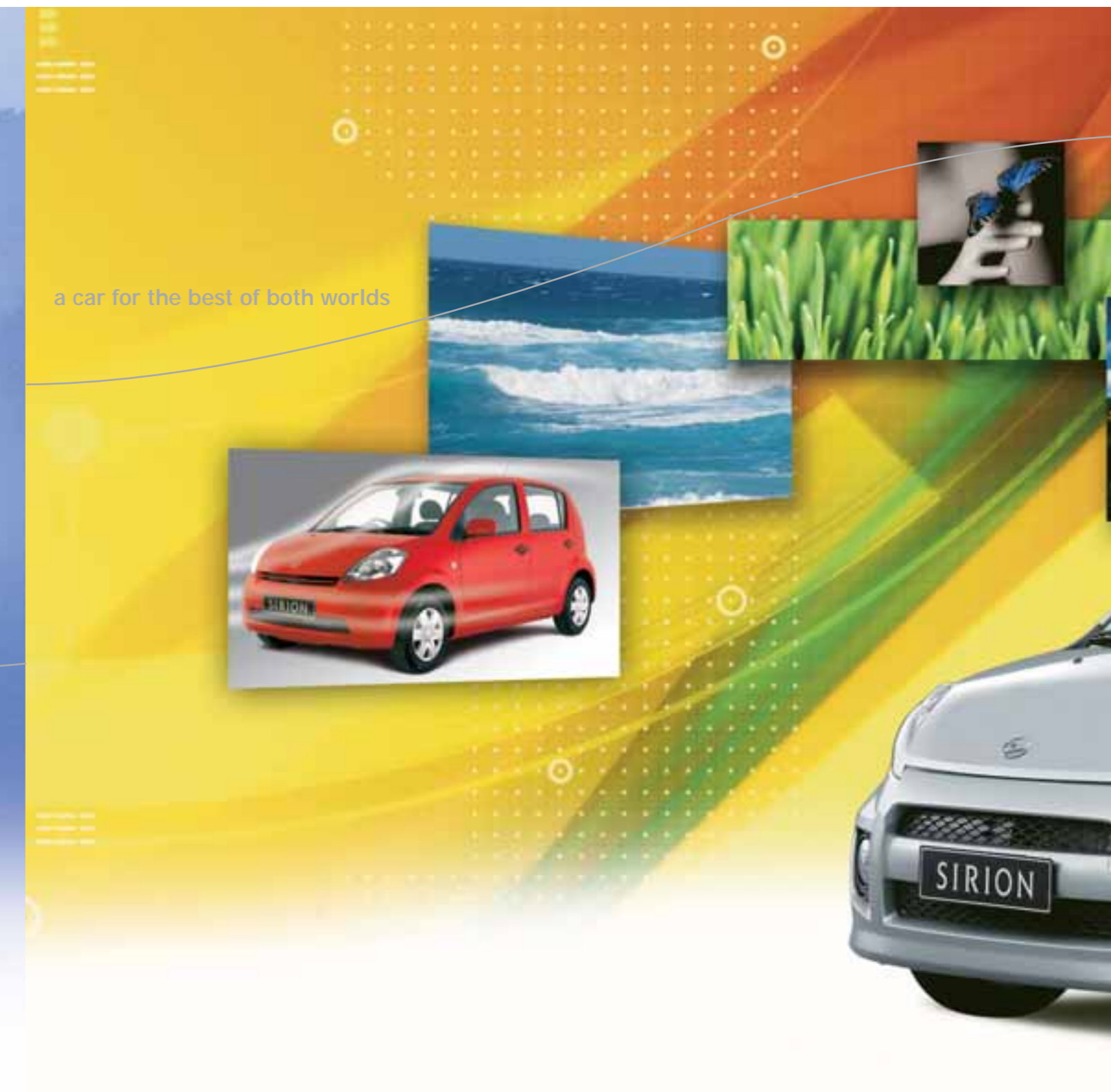
Daihatsu have been building engines since 1907 so you could say they have some experience. Today, our engines are so reliable, so fuel efficient, have such low emissions and yet are amongst the most powerful in their class.

So what makes these engines so special? Both the 1.0 litre and the 1.3 litre use Dynamic Variable Valve Timing that optimises engine settings to give maximum performance at all times. The 1.0 litre engine features a revolutionary design that achieves an exceptionally small size and light weight. Both engines use aluminium

and advanced polymer plastics extensively, to cut down weight.

Combine that with a smooth aerodynamic shape that has a Cd value of 0.31, which cuts wind resistance to a minimum, reduces wind noise and helps achieve exceptional fuel economy and you've got a car that is designed to deliver more miles for your money than most other cars in its class could dream of.

The overview...

Built to exceed expectations the Sirion is an exceptional car, class leading in so many areas:

- Interior space
- Comfort and equipment
- Manoeuvrability
- Fuel consumption

Remote central locking, wide opening doors and a comfortably raised seating position make getting in and out effortless.

Even with 3 passengers in the rear, there is an amazing amount of headroom, legroom and make-yourself-comfortable room for everyone. And with front seats that slide backwards and forwards 240mm, ample space between the driver and passenger and a steering wheel that adjusts up and down by 30mm, the Sirion is happy to accommodate all shapes and sizes.

As is the wide, low level boot which converts quickly into a large loading bay thanks to the 60:40 split, fold-flat rear seats, which benefit from two different recline positions and ISOFIX anchorage points for child seats.

All models come with air conditioning as standard. For the driver, the speedometer is mounted on the steering column, so with the column adjusted for a perfect driving position the instrument panel is never obstructed. For your rear passengers there are 3 headrests, 2-position adjustable back rests and wide arm rests on the doors.

Even the small details are not forgotten. For example: go over 9 mph and if your front seat passenger has not fitted their safety belt securely a light and buzzer will bring this to your attention. The tailgate is opened or locked by the remote central locking. The rear wiper has an intermittent delay making it easier to keep your rear screen clear at all times. And just to make sure you really enjoy the drive there is an integrated radio/CD player with large easy to use controls for your listening pleasure.



The Boot ...

The interior of the Sirion is one of the widest in its class. And it shows. Try loading a couple of golf bags in the boot – no don't put the rear seats down, you don't need to – you will find the golf bags just fit in. Need a safe place to stow fragile items? Open rear door, pull the seat squab forward – now you have a loading area for those fragile items. They can't fall on the floor. Pull the backrest down – now you have a flat load area to play with. Versatility is the name of the game.



The Technical Bit ...

You've seen inside the cabin, now what's beneath the bonnet?

Let's cut to the chase. Both the 1.0 litre and the 1.3 litre are pretty much class leading engines. Both employ Dynamic Variable Valve Timing to ensure optimum performance. The 1.0 litre Sirion gives 56.5 mpg on the combined cycle. And the CO₂ emissions are only 118 g/km. Both fuel consumption and the low emissions are class leading. You could be forgiven thinking that this is all at the cost of performance. Well with acceleration of 0-62 mph of 13.9 seconds the Sirion 1.0 litre is amongst the fastest in its class, giving safer overtaking.

Need more power? Then try the 1.3 litre Sirion. With 48.7 mpg on the combined cycle and emissions of 137 g/km it is still kind on the pocket and also on the planet. An acceleration time of 11.3 seconds for 0-62 mph is up with the best in class.

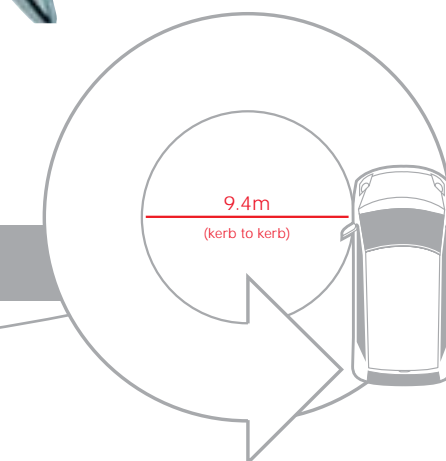
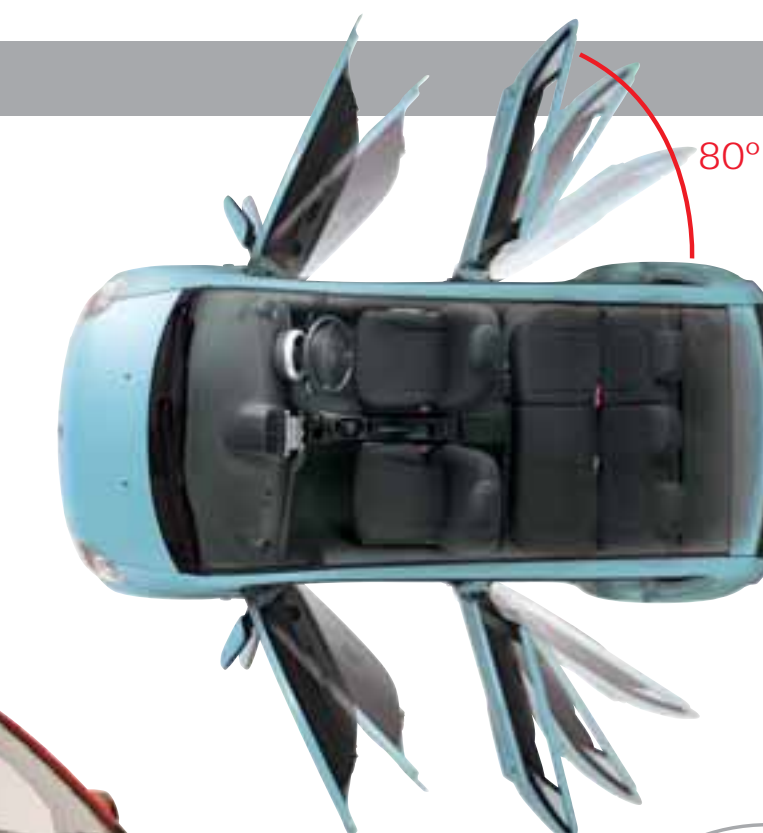
But the new Sirion doesn't just deliver the unexpected: it protects you from the unexpected, too.

Don't let the short bonnet lull you into a false sense of insecurity: the new Sirion is designed to achieve the top safety level in its class for protecting occupants in the event of front, rear or side collision with vehicles of all sizes.

The cabin is protected by an advanced, shock-absorbing structure and the brake and clutch pedals are designed not to intrude into the cabin in the event of a collision. There are head restraints for all three rear passengers and the rear seat offers ISOFIX anchorage points for child safety seats – on both sides. We've even designed the Sirion's body to minimise pedestrian injury.

All Sirions have driver, passenger and side airbags, and an Anti-lock Braking System (ABS), which uses an electronic brakeforce distributor to assure optimum distribution of braking force between front and rear (EBD).

With the new Sirion you can enjoy all the freedom, economy and nimble performance that a great car has to offer, without sacrificing any of the safety and security that you owe to yourself and your family.



The Sirion loves a tight squeeze. Although its wheelbase is as long – if not longer – than many other small cars in its class, the Sirion has a minimum turning circle of 9.4m.

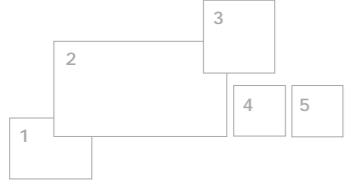

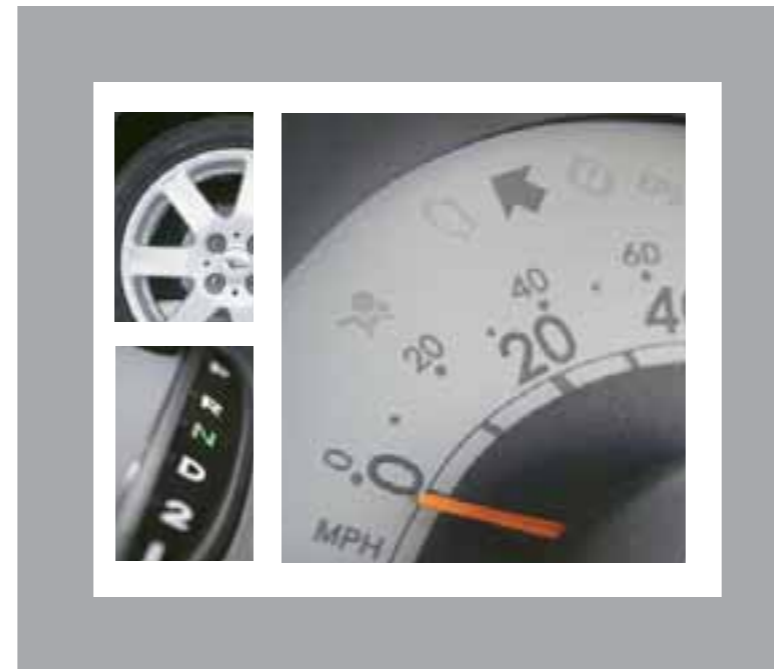
